### FACT SHEET

The **AYS Young Men's Power Sing** program is designed to encourage young men in our schools and communities to sing. A day of workshops, fun and performance in a male-only environment gives boys at all levels a chance to explore the voice freely without the pressure of the mixed gender setting.

### WORKSHOPS and PERFORMANCE

- Two instructional tracks meet the needs of young men's changing voices  
**9AM-5PM** changed voices  
**1PM-5PM** unchanged voices
- Workshops and Performance are **FREE OF CHARGE** for all participants
- 2017 YMPS clinicians to be announced. Former clinicians have included Dr. David Morrow, Dr. Mel Foster, Dr Uzee Brown of Morehouse College, Matt Oltman, former Music Director of Chanticleer, and Dr. Alan Stevens of East Tennessee State University. Additional instructors have included Ariel Merivil, Jerry Fields, Lorenzo Sanford, and Jelani Watkins.
- Singers will wear their school's concert dress for the performance. If not currently members of school choirs, they are asked to dress in white shirts and black pants.
- Educators may send a balanced quartet (or double), but not necessary
- AYS will provide singers with scores for 4 pieces and folders to use for the day
